



We see the hand of God in our lives constantly, and note how abundant it is when taking the time to reflect and review. Sometimes God just puts out his hand for us to see in a very dramatic and unmistakable way.

The other day, as we were driving home, we found ourselves behind a large, cross-country tour bus. We were on a narrow two-lane road which often reduced, at times, to one lane. We, then, would have to manoeuvre to a wider, pull-in space provided so that the oncoming car could pass. I had just remarked that the bus was clearing the way for us to follow steadily. Suddenly there was a loud bang and the bus veered into the nearside bank and tilted radically. Bruce instinctively 'stood' on the brake and screeched to an immediate stop as we witnessed a red convertible barreling toward us in our lane. The bus and car had somehow glanced off each other. The bus had a caved-in side and the front-wheel drive car had its axel and right wheel shattered, the driver later saying he was unable to steer at all . . . "something mysteriously pulled us into the path of the bus and then pulled us back again". There had been no way to avoid a head-on collision, so we braced ourselves . . . and that's when the car just jerked back to the correct side of the road and came to rest in a bush. **We are convinced that an angel just brushed the oncoming car aside!** We sat motionless, panting, breathless with eyes glued open wondering what happened. Was it a shocking dream . . . were we awake . . . or what?

Bruce hopped out to find a couple quite shaken but unhurt. The wife managed to climb out but Bruce had to help the husband out of her side since there was so much damage. There were no injuries in the bus. Everyone had been protected from a potentially fatal crash. There wasn't even a scratch on our car despite flying debris.

Psalm 27 speaks of God's guidance and protection. Read the whole Psalm but notice verse 5: *For he will hide me in his shelter in the day of trouble; he will conceal me under the cover of his tent; he will lift me high upon a rock.* We praise the Lord for his guidance and protection!

Ben and Tanya have a second interview with the US Embassy in Kiev to register the birth of their youngest child, Sonya, and secure an American passport. This is a more difficult procedure since Ben has lived most of his life outside the USA - he has to produce verification of being at least five years physically present in the US, two of which have to have been between age 14 and Sonya's birth. Old school records during furlough years have been sought, old passports have been combed, records of where we travelled or lived have been tracked down and all these have had to be notarized.

Please pray for the final Embassy appointment coming Wednesday, 15 September. Again, God is in control . . . to bring about the decision He wants at the right time, to calm our concerns, to keep stress under control. This 'exercise' has affected all of us - parents and grandparents - and our role as Field Administrator for IGO.

This month Bruce flew to southern Spain to participate in the annual Spanish National Committee meeting in Malaga as a representative of Partners In Evangelism International. In his role as European Area Director it is a joy to work with the national churches and missionaries. The church in Malaga is special to us and the pastor and family are especially dear to our hearts.

This church has experienced several major setbacks in its short life. Our national missionary is now the acting pastor with a big task ahead of him to rebuild and refocus the church. Please pray for Pablo and Rosa.

Thank you for your care for us. We are aware you are part of God's protection over us and his provision for us. And, as counsel, you are part of God's guidance.
